Comments / Explanations:

The explanation for the late notification of riders for trainers V Poke and S Lockhart were accepted.

RACE 1 – TASSAL MAIDEN– 1200 METRES

Kunanyi (D Tootell) – Rider D Tootell was harmlessly dislodged when leaving the mounting yard. Commenced awkwardly shifted out and steadied off heels.

Real Acclaim (T Voorham) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Gee Gee Runaway (D Ganderton) – Bumped at the start with Oh So Needy.

Roitfeld (E Kacmaz) – Underwent a veterinary examination after arriving on course and was subsequently passed fit to run, after the mare had not race since the 1st of February 2017 due to a tendon injury. Shifted in at the start, tightening Flannie in onto Highvoice and became unbalanced.

Flannie (A Patis) – Checked at the start when tightened for room between Roitfeld, which shifted in and Hivoice.

Furthernova (S Carr) – Near the 1000 metres, steadied when taken inward by Snippetty Cat (M Ulucinar), which shifted in when not fully clear. M Ulucinar was severely reprimanded under AR131(a) careless riding.

Hivoice (B Muhcu) – Bumped at the start, shifted in and steadied off the heels of Furthernova.

Midnight Mosh (G Catania) – Slow into stride. Rounding the home turn, momentarily inconvenienced by Hivoice, (B Muchu), which shifted in. B Muchu was advised to exercise care when shifting ground. Raced greenly and lay out in the home straight.

Oh So Needy (T Germaine) – Bumped at the start with Gee Gee Runaway.

RACE 2 – HARVEY NORMAN LAUNCESTON HOME APPLIANCES BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP– 1200 METRES

Correct weight was delayed when rider of the second place getter, T Baker (Motown Blues) lodged an protest against Silver Road, (C Newitt) being declared the winner, alleging interference approaching

the winning post. It was established that approaching the winning post, Silver Road had shifted in and bumped with Motown Blues, however given the close proximity of the bump to the winning post, Stewards dismissed the protest.

Epic Event (T Voorham) – Incorrectly shown in the race book as not wearing blinkers.
Silver Road (C Newitt) – Shifted in approaching the winning post, bumped with Motown Blues.

Motown Blues (T Baker) – Approaching the winning post bumped with Silver Road.

Jupiter's Moon (S Tsaikos) – Momentarily held up rounding the home turn.

Pontypaul (D Tootell) – Shifted in on jumping away.

Little Pumba (C Graham) – Steadied at the start when tightened for room between Gee Gee Pureblonde and Pontypaul which shifted in. Over the concluding stages, held up and unable to be ridden out to the finish.

Ansaam (E Kacmaz) – Over raced in the early and middle stages. Passing the 800 metres, when over racing improved up onto the heels of Motown Blues, having to be steadied, and shifting wider on the track.

Gee Gees Can Tell (S So) – Commenced awkwardly and shifted out. Raced wide without cover throughout.

Kepta (R Bishop) – Rider R Bishop was granted permission to ride the mare half a kilo over its allotted weight. Checked at the start by Gee Gees Can Tell, which shifted out.

RACE 3 – HARVEY NORMAN LAUNCESTON TECHNOLOGY CLASS 1 HANDICAP– 1400 METRES

Limerick City (S Tsaikos) – Lay out rounding the home turn. Performed below expectations. Rider S Tsaikos could offer no explanation for the performance. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.

Glifi Nifin Arkis (C Graham) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Lay in under pressure in the home straight. Rider C Graham stated that after racing wide, the gelding was slightly disappointing in the home straight.

Mountain Music (T Voorham) – Held up rounding the home turn.

Countess Delta (B Muhcu) – Held up for clear running between the 400 metres and 100 metres.

Fontein Harry (C Newitt) – Held up rounding the home turn.

Miss Iso (D Tootell) – Near the 150 metres, momentarily tightened between Glifi Nifin Arkis, which lay in and Totally Wicked which shifted out slightly.

Foreeva (T Baker) – Held up rounding the home turn and in the early part of the home straight.

Tack upgraded to a good 4 after the running of this event.

RACE 4 – HARVEY NORMAN LAUNCESTON FURNITURE BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP– 1400 METRES

Thanos (A Patis) – Rounding the home turn, had to be steadied when momentarily tightened between Mulley's Idol and George's Gambol, which had shifted out.

Jack's Choice (T Germaine) – Raced three wide without cover until the 800 metres. On the latter part of the home turn, had to be steadied when momentarily tightened between Mulley's Idol and Clever Charlotte which shifted out slightly. Rider T Germaine was severely reprimanded under AR227(a) negligence for initially weighing in without his lead bag before it was located within the saddle cloth.

Boart (R Bishop) – At the start tightened for room between Mulley's Idol and Clever Charlotte, which had shifted in slightly.

Breathtaking (C Newitt) – Slow into stride, shifted out having to be steadied off the heels of Goodbye Lonesome.

Clever Charlotte (D Tootell) – Raced three wide without cover from the 800 metres. Performed below expectations. Rider D Tootell explained that after racing wide, the filly failed to finish off the race.

George's Gambol (S Tsaikos) – Rounding the home turn had to be steadied when held up and disappointed for a run between Thanos and Jack's Choice.

RACE 5 – HARVEY NORMAN LAUNCESTON FLOORING BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP– 1600 METRES

Prior to correct weight, connections of the second place getter, (Supergrass) and third place getter, (Aventador) viewed the films of the home straight. After doing so they were satisfied and correct weight was declared.

Sentimental Dream (T Germaine) – Performed below expectations. A Post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the off fore leg and will require a veterinary clearance prior to racing again.

Axion (C Newitt) – Checked at the start between Caesar's Quest, which shifted in and Alfred Street.

Alfred Street (T Baker) – Rider T Baker stated that the gelding raced flat and may have come to the end of its preparation.

Gee Gee Fiorente (B McCoull) – Trainer L Wells was fined the sum of \$50 under AR106(1), for presenting the gelding to the mounting yard with the incorrect gear.

Aventador (S Tsaikos) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Somerset (A Patis) – Slow into stride. Approaching the 800 metres carried wider on the track by Olly's A Star,(E Kacmaz) which shifted out to avoid the heels of Heaven's Delight. E Kacmaz was advised to exercise far greater care when in similar situations.

Supergrass (S Carr) – Near the 1500 metres, bumped on the hind quarters by Heaven's Delight.

Heaven's Delight (B Muhcu) – Near the 1500 metres, bumped with Supergrass.

Olly's A Star (E Kacmaz) – Approaching the 800 metres, steadied when improved up onto the heels of Heaven's Delight.

RACE 6 – HARVEY NORMAN LAUNCESTON BENCHMARK 72 HANDICAP– 1100 METRES

Gee Gees Queenie (P Lui) – Commenced awkwardly. Raced wide without cover throughout.

Tough Missile (B Muhcu) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Uber Ed (S Carr) – Lay out rounding the home turn.

Silzoar (C Newitt) – Approaching the 400 metres, blundered and became unbalanced. Rider C Newitt explained that after dipping in the going, approaching the home turn, the gelding felt awkward in its action and he was reluctant to place it under pressure in the home straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near fore and will require a veterinary certificate prior to racing.

Westerly Haze (T Baker) – Held up rounding the home turn.

RACE 7 – HARVEY NORMAN LAUNCESTON BEDDING MAIDEN/CLASS 1 – 2100 METRES

Noosafy (T Germaine) – Near the 800 metres, steadied when momentarily tightened between Pinkeyes Pride and Style Guru, (D Tootell) which shifted in. D Tootell was advised to exercise care.

Furrenzy (T Voorham) – Held up rounding the home turn. Passing the 400 metres when attempting a run where barely sufficient room to the inside of Style Guru made contact with that gelding.

Style Guru (NZ) (D Tootell) – Slow into stride. Rounding the home turn became unbalanced when bumped by Furrenzy, (T Voorham) when that mare attempted a run to the inside where barely sufficient room. T Voorham was severely reprimanded and advised to exercise far greater care in similar circumstances.

Uncovered (T Baker) – Slow into stride.

Pinkeyes Pride (S Tsaikos) – Underwent a veterinary examination after an incident on the float on route to the course and passed suitable to race.

Our Rossa (S Carr) - Underwent a veterinary examination after an incident on the float on route to the course and passed suitable to race.

RACE 8 – HARVEY NORMAN LAUNCESTON KITCHEN CENTRE BENCHMARK 64– 2100 METRES

One Way Ticket (NZ) (C Graham) – Rider C Graham was reminded of his obligations to ensure he rides his mounts out fully to the finish.

Pelagia (C Newitt) – Held up rounding the home turn.

Son Of Faith (S Carr) – Rider S Carr explained that she had been instructed to commence a move and place the gelding under pressure from the 600 metres. Ms Carr added that the gelding should derive benefit from the run after stepping up in distance.

C'est Bon (T Baker) – On jumping away, rider T Baker momentarily lost the use of his near side iron. Performed below expectations. Rider T Baker could offer no explanation for the performance. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.
