### *Comments / Explanations:*

#### **RACE 1 – FROTHY MAIDEN 2-Y-O & Up. Mdn – 1200 METRES**

**Pingu** (A Darmanin) – Bumped at the start with Ipotane.

**Snippety Cat** (C Graham) – Rider C Graham reported that the gelding was inclined to lay out during the run.

**A Tad More** (T Voorham) – After being slow into stride was then tightened for room between Midnight Quest, which shifted out and Chevalin. Held up for clear running between the 400 metres and 200 metres.

**Chevalin** (R Clark) – Approaching the 800 metres steadied away from the heels of Kombacy (I Toker) which shifted in when not fully clear. I Toker will be advised to exercise more care in future. Approaching the winning post, checked off the heels of Midnight Quest, (D Parish) which shifted out.

**Ipotane** (T Baker) – Bumped at the start with Pingu.

**Kombacy** (I Toker) – Trainer J Blacker was fined the sum of \$50 for the late addition of winkers to the filly. Rider I Toker reported that the filly was inclined to lay in during the run.

**Gee Gees Lovebeer** (R Bishop) – Bumped at the start with Still A Star. Near the 1100 metres had to be steadied when momentarily tightened between Still A Star, which shifted in when over racing and Snippety Cat.

**Still A Star** (S Carr) – Bumped at the start with Gee Gees Lovebeer. Over raced in the early and middle stages. Raced three wide without cover throughout. Lay in in the home straight.

D Parish,(Midnight Quest) pleaded guilty to a charge under AR131(a), careless riding. The carelessness being that approaching the winning post she permitted her mount to shift out when insufficiently clear of Chevalin, resulting in that gelding contacting the heels of Midnight Quest and having to be checked. D Parish had her licence suspended for 1 Tasmanian race meeting to commence at midnight 24<sup>th</sup> April 2019 and expire at midnight 28<sup>th</sup> April 2019. In determining penalty Stewards took into account the D Parish guilty plea, her record and the incident was deemed to be low range.

## **RACE 2 – DELORAIN COMMUNITY CUP 5TH MAY CLASS 1 HANDICAP – 1200 METRES**

The start of this race was delayed when the saddles for Fitzwilliam and Geegees Cash Cow were required to be reweighed which led to these runners arriving late to the barrier. As there were a number of contributing factors which led to this occurring no action was taken.

**Lesnar** (C Newitt) – Bumped at the start by Gee Gee Musicmaker, which shifted in.

**Newts** (B McCoull) – Checked at the start when bumped heavily by Knitting.

**Acheeva Dream** (E Kacmaz) – Underwent a veterinary examination after arriving on course as the gelding had not started in a race since the 3<sup>rd</sup> of September 2017 due to a tendon injury. Subsequently passed suitable to race. Commenced awkwardly, shortly after, checked when tightened between Lesnar, which had been taken outward by Gee Gee Musicmaker and Geegees Cashcow which had been taken outward by Fitzwilliam.

**Gee Gee Ladybird** (S Carr) – Underwent a veterinary examination after arriving on course as the filly had not started in a race since the 28th of March 2018 after having a bone chip removed. Subsequently passed suitable to race.

**Fitzwilliam** (R Bishop) – Shifted out at the start and bumped with Geegees Cashcow.

**Geegees Cash Cow** (T Voorham) – Bumped at the start with Fitzwilliam, which shifted out.

**Knitting** (A Patis) – Shifted out at the start and bumped heavily with Newts.

**Gee Gee Musicmaker** (S So) – Bumped with Lesnar at the start after shifting in. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

## **RACE 3 – STEVE'S LIQUOR 2YO MAIDEN 2-Y-O. MAIDEN – 1100 METRES**

**Dixie's Boy** (T Baker) – Raced greenly throughout.

**Effie** (A Patis) – Proved difficult to load which delayed the start. A warning was issued.

**Get The Trip** (B Muhcu) – Momentarily held up for clear running rounding the home turn.

**Revolution Queen** (R Clark) – Proved difficult to load which delayed the start. A warning was issued. Near the 800 metres dipped, becoming slightly unbalanced. Rider R Clark reported the filly raced greenly.

**Sardegna Deel** (C Newitt) – Raced greenly.

**Silverware** (E Kacmaz) – Inconvenienced at the start between Get The Trip and Rhyme Writer.

**Stepaside Rousey** (A Darmanin) – Raced greenly and lay in in the home straight.

## **RACE 4 – AUSTRALIAN TRAINERS ASSOCIATION MAIDEN – 1400 METRES**

**Banca Nip** (S Carr) – Slow into stride. Shortly after the start attempted to buck. A warning was issued.

**Wineglass Bay** (E Kacmaz) – Approaching the 800 metres steadied off the heels of Smooth Pebbles.

**Gee Gees Keylargo** (B McCoull) – Raced wide without cover until the 800 metres. Performed below expectations. Rider B McCoull explained that the gelding had to work hard in the early stages when racing wide to take up a forward position and did not appreciate being crowded rounding the home turn, however was under pressure at that stage and not responding. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.

**Orange Roughie** (B Muhcu) – Trainer R Carr was fined the sum of \$50 for the late removal of blinkers from the gelding. Slow into stride.

**Kel's Star** (G Catania) – Brushed with Smooth Pebbles near the 100 metres and again near the 50 metres.

**Smooth Pebbles** (S Tsaikos) – Approaching the 800 metres, shifted out slightly over the heels of Araya Hope, bumping with Buzzard then commenced to over race for a short period and steadied off the heels of Araya Hope. Brushed with Kel's Star near the 100 metres and again near the 50 metres.

**Bigable** (T Voorham) – Momentarily held up rounding the home turn. Rider T Voorham explained that she had been instructed to ride the filly with cover today. Trainer L Laskey confirmed these instructions. L Laskey explained that he had not expected the filly to be ridden as far forward as at was at Devonport on 14 April 2019, however the filly may have got a little further back than intended tonight.

**Buzzered** (A Darmanin) – Approaching the 800 metres bumped with Smooth Pebbles. Raced three wide without cover for the majority of the race.

### **RACE 5 – ANZAC REMEMBRANCE 3YO AUTUMN CLASSIC – 1400 METRES**

**Alinjer** (C Newitt) – Rider C Newitt reported that the gelding raced flat and may have come to the end of its preparation.

**Gee Gee True Story** (B McCoull) – Rider B McCoull reported that the gelding may have come to the end of its preparation. Co-trainer L Wells confirmed the gelding would now go for a short let up.

**Border Protection** (D Ganderton) – Late scratching at 2.55pm on veterinary advice. A veterinary clearance required prior to racing again.

**Diesel Dan** (B Muhcu) – Slow into stride. Shortly after checked off the heels of Miltons, which shifted in.

**Le Monde De Lucas** (R Bishop) – Carried inward at the start by Alinjer and then bumped with Miltons. Inconvenienced at the 1200 metres. Raced greenly for the majority of the race.

**Miltons** (G Catania) – Shifted in after the start and then bumped with Le Monde De Lucas.

**Furtheronova** (S Carr) – Approaching the 1200 metres had to be checked when tightened for room between Alinjer which had been taken inward by Mountain Music and Gee Gee True Story. Over raced during the middle stages. Rider S Carr reported that the filly lay out throughout.

T Voorham (Mountain Music), pleaded guilty to a charge under AR131(a) careless riding. The carelessness being that approaching the 1200 metres she permitted her mount to shift in when insufficiently clear of Alinjer, which was tightened in onto Furtheronover which had to be checked. T Voorham's licence to ride in races was suspended for 1 Tasmanian race meeting to commence at midnight the 28<sup>th</sup> of April 2019 and expire midnight 5<sup>th</sup> of May 2019. In determining penalty Stewards took into consideration T Voorham's guilty plea, her record, the race manners of Furtheronover and the incident was determined to be mid range.

### **RACE 6 – TAB AUTUMN HANDICAP – 1400 METRES**

**Beaufort Lad** (C Newitt) – Inconvenienced rounding the home turn by Speedonova.

**Speedonova** (R Clark) – Held up and steadied rounding the home turn when attempting to take a run to the inside of Minute Repeater, where there was insufficient room. Rider R Clark was reprimanded and advised to ensure that she has sufficient racing room when attempting to take runs. Lay in in the home straight.

**Punta Norte** (A Darmanin) – A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the off fore. A veterinary clearance is required prior to racing again.

**Magnasa** (C Graham) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

**Bosporus** (B Muhcu) – Rider B Muhcu stated that the gelding may not have appreciated tonight's shifting track conditions.

#### **RACE 7 – AUTOBARN LAUNCESTON MAIDEN/CLASS 1– 1600 METRES**

**Stormont** (B McCoull) – Approaching the 100 metres, tightened for room between Bullion Fringe, which had shifted out and Pira Noona.

**Roulette Star** (T Baker) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

**Bullion Fringe** (B Muhcu) – Slow into stride. Momentarily held up rounding the home turn.

**Sky Fox** (A Darmanin) – Raced wide in the early stages before being allowed to stride forward to take up the lead passing the 1200 metres.

**Pira Noona** (R Clark) – Near the 1400 metres, steadied when momentarily tightened for room between Miss Tangerine and Fontein Harry which had been taken in by Sky Fox, (A Darmanin). A Darmanin was advised to exercise care when shifting ground. Over raced in the early and middle stages.

**Miss Tangerine** (A Patis) – On the later part of the home turn was steadied when racing tightly to the inside of Bullion Fringe.

B Muhcu (Bullion Fringe) was found guilty of a charge under AR131(a), careless riding. The carelessness being that approaching the 100 metres he permitted his mount to shift out when insufficiently clear of Stormont, resulting in that gelding being tightened for room and having to be restrained to avoid the heels of Pira Noona. B Muhcu licence to ride in races was suspended for 1 Tasmanian race meeting to commence at midnight the 28<sup>th</sup> of April 2019 and expire midnight the 5<sup>th</sup> May 2019. In determining penalty Stewards took into account B Muhcu good record and that the incident was deemed to be low range.

#### **RACE 8 – FAMILY FUN FAIR @ MOWBRAY RACECOURSE BM64 HANDICAP – 1200 METRES**

**Gee Gee Spitfire** (R Bishop) – Near the 600 metres was steadied when Party Planner (T Voorham), shifted out when not quite clear. T Voorham was advised to exercise care when shifting ground.

**Shewearsthepants** (NZ) (S Carr) – Underwent a veterinary examination after arriving on course as the mare had not started in a race since the 17<sup>th</sup> of October 2017 after having some minor tendon injuries. Subsequently passed fit to start.

**Forever Alone** (C Graham) – Bumped at the start with George's Gambol.

**Party Planner** (T Voorham) – Performed below expectations. Rider T Voorham explained that the mare may not have been suited by tonight's shifting track conditions. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.

**George's Gambol** (S Tsaikos) – Bumped at the start with Forever Alone.
