### ***Comments / Explanations:***

Race 7 was incorrectly shown in the race book as 3:58pm and not 3:48pm

### **RACE 1 – FIRST NATIONAL REAL ESTATE CLARIDGE MAIDEN / CLASS 1– 1600 METRES**

**Nidoking** (C Graham) – Slow into stride.

**Stormont** (B McCoull) – Raced wide from the 800 metres. Rider B McCoull stated that the gelding may be better suited over a further distance.

**Countess Delta** (B Muhcu) – Momentarily held up rounding the home turn.

**Encosta's Reward** (I Toker) – Lay out under pressure in the home straight. Rider I Toker explained that the horse raced greenly. I Toker was advised to make greater effort to straighten his mounts than he did on this occasion.

**Sky Fox** (A Darmanin) – After becoming fractious in the barrier, underwent a veterinary examination and passed suitable to race. Rider A Darmanin was examined by the medical officers and passed fit to fulfil his riding engagements. This delayed the start. A warning has been placed on the colt.

**Fearless Filou (NZ)** (E Kacmaz) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. The saddle slipped forward in the early stages placing rider E Kacmaz at a severe disadvantage.

### **RACE 2 – J.G PEST CONTROL PTY LTD MAIDEN 2-Y-O & Up – 1400 METRES**

Correct weight was delayed when B McCoull (Furtheronova), wished to view the replay of the start, to determine if he had been denied a fair start. After doing so he was satisfied and correct weight was declared.

**Orange Roughie (B Muhcu)** – Near the 1200 metres restrained when tightened for room by Terrific Torri (R Bishop) which shifted in, R Bishop was advised to exercise care when shifting ground. Approaching the 100 metres steadied off the heels off Flannie (I Toker) which shifted out when not fully clear. I Toker was reprimanded under AR131(a) careless riding.

**Snippety Cat** (C Graham) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

**Bonduel Lily** (M Ulucinar) – Rider M Ulucinar was reminded of his obligations to ensure he rides his mounts out fully to the finish.

**Buzzered** (A Darmanin) – Rider A Darmanin explained that he had been instructed to ride the filly positive and after riding with vigour early he was able to take up the lead with little resistance. Trainer C Thompson confirmed these instructions. C Thompson added that he had not changed anything with the filly's routine and had been disappointed with the filly's past performances as it has shown ability in training.

**Crystal's Pass** (C Newitt) – Held up for clear running between the 400 metres and 200 metres.

**Furtheronova** (B McCoull) – Shortly after the start, restrained when momentarily tightened between Smooth Pebbles and Araya Hope. B McCoull explained that the filly raced further back in the run than intended and lay out throughout. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the filly to be lame in the off fore leg and will require a veterinary certificate prior to racing again

**Smooth Pebbles** (A Patis) – Rider A Patis explained that the mare may be better suited to a firmer track than today's.

### **RACE 3 – DELORAINE HOTEL CLASS 1 HANDICAP – 1400 METRES**

**Rough Road** (T Germaine) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

**Pretzel Logic** (C Graham) – Performed below expectations. Rider C Graham explained that the filly felt uncomfortable in its action. A Post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities. Stewards will follow up with trainer A Trinder regarding the performance.

**I Am the Dude** (S Carr) – Rider S Carr reported that the gelding raced ungenerously in the early stages. Rounding the home turn, tightened for room when disappointed for a run to the inside of Vivid Dreamer (B McCoull), which shifted in slightly, this was aggravated when Pretzel Logic which was racing to the outside of Vivid Dreamer shifting in slightly resulting in B McCoull being unable to relieve any pressure. Given the circumstances B McCoull was advised to exercise care. Had difficulty obtaining clear running between the 300 metres and 100 metres.

**Vivid Dreamer** (B McCoull) – Held up over the final 50 metres and was unable to be ridden out to the finish.

**Arving** (M Ulucinar) – Held up rounding the home turn. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination after slipping over in the mounting yard subsequent to the race which revealed a small graze below the left knee.

**Totally Wicked** (A Darmanin) – Rider A Darmanin reported that the gelding hung out throughout. A Post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.

### **RACE 4 – MEANDER VALLEY COUNCIL 2YO HANDICAP 2-Y-O – 1200 METRES**

**Effie** (A Patis) – Required to be resaddled at the barrier. Shortly after the start, checked when tightened between Fitzwilliam, which shifted out and Still A Star. Performed below expectations. Rider A Patis explained that the filly lay out throughout the race. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a superficial wound to the hock.

**Ressy Ranger** (T Germaine) – Tailed off from the 500 metres and was not ridden out in the home straight. Rider T Germaine explained that the gelding raced greenly and failed to respond to his riding when placed under pressure. Trainer J Blacker advised that the gelding will now be sent for a spell. The gelding must trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing again for being uncompetitive.

### **RACE 5 – BLAIR & SONS SAWMILL BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP – 1600 METRES**

**Pelagia** (T Germaine) – Slow into stride.

**Axion** (I Toker) – Rider I Toker explained that after beginning well the gelding raced slightly further forward than intended.

**Supergrass** (S Carr) – Near the 300 metres, steadied away from the heels of Somerset, (B Muhcu), which shifted out when not fully clear. B Muhcu was reprimanded under AR131(a), careless riding. Performed below expectations. Rider S Carr could offer no explanation for the performance, other than the gelding failed to respond to her riding when placed under pressure. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.

**Somerset** (B Muhcu) – Slow into stride.

**Son of Faith** (A Darmanin) – Raced three wide without cover in the early stages.

**Heaven's Delight** (C Newitt) – Raced four wide without cover in the early stages. Performed below expectations. Rider C Newitt explained that after beginning well the mare raced further forward than intended. C Newitt added that the mare may not have been suited by today's track conditions.

**All Well (Ire)** (M Ulucinar) – Rider M Ulucinar was granted permission to ride 1kg over the allotted weight. Raced three wide without cover from the 800 metres.

### **RACE 6 – DELORAINE COMMUNITY CUP OPEN HANDICAP – 1600 METRES**

Prior to correct weight B Muhcu (Beauford Lad) wished to view the official replay of the home straight. After doing so he was satisfied and correct weight was declared.

**Kenjorwood** (S Carr) – Rider S Carr reported the gelding was off the bit and under pressure from the 500 metres.

**Speed Force** (B McCoull) – Near the 500 metres, bumped with Agree To when shifting out to obtain clear running. Lay out in the home straight. Rider B McCoull stated that it was his intention to race wider in the home straight as he was of the view that this was the better part of the track, however the gelding lay out under pressure, taking him wider than he intended.

**Zatacla** (C Graham) – Rider C Graham, reported that the gelding may be better suited to a firmer track than today's.

**Fragment** (C Newitt) – Performed below expectations. Rider C Newitt could offer no explanation for the performance. A Post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.

**Agree To** (T Baker) – Near the 500 metres, bumped by Speed Force (B McCoull), which shifted out to obtain clear running. B McCoull was advised to exercise care when shifting ground.

**Magnasa** (I Toker) – Prior to race 5 trainer J Blacker made application to scratch the gelding as he was of the view the gelding would not be suited by today's track conditions given its past injury problems. After consideration, this application was denied given the track category had not been changed by Stewards subsequent to final scratching's.

### **RACE 7 – BRITISH HOTEL BENCHMARK 72 HANDICAP – 1400 METRES**

**Step the Pedal** (C Graham) – Shortly after the start, checked when tightened for room between Balearic and Exclusive Saturday, which had been taken inwards by The Master Speed, (E Kacmaz). E Kacmaz was advised to exercise care and to make a greater effort to straighten his mounts than he did on this occasion.

**The Master Speed** (E Kacmaz) – Shifted in shortly after the start.

**The words out** (T Baker) – Passing the 1200 metres, got its head up when over racing. Rider T Baker stated that the gelding over-raced in the early stages.

**Exclusive Saturday** (A Darmanin) – Shortly after the start, was carried inward by the Master Speed. Raced three wide without cover in the early stages. Inclined to lay out in the home straight. Rider A Darmanin reported that the gelding was inclined to lay out in the home straight.

**Shewearsthepants (NZ)** (S Carr) – Rider S Carr reported that the mare was inclined to lay in in the home straight.

**Paper Kites** (M Ulucinar) - Rider M Ulucinar was granted permission to ride 1kg over the allotted weight. Commenced awkwardly and was slow into stride.

### **RACE 8 – KELLY GANG TIMBERS BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP – 1200 METRES**

**Invincible Rock** (S Carr) – Rider S Carr reported that the gelding lay in for the majority of the race. S Carr added that she would look at altering the gelding's gear prior to its next start.

**Brockton Punch** (M Ulucinar) – Near the 800 metres, momentarily tightened for room by Remigny, which lay in.

**Gee Gees Style** (P Lui) – As the start was affected had its head turned to the side and as a result, commenced awkwardly and lost ground. Apprentice P Lui along with his master Mr L Wells were shown the replay of the start and this will be referred to apprentice school for further tuition. Rider P Lui was reminded of his obligations when using his whip when a horse is out of contention.

**Qui Samer** (B McCoull) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

**Remigny** (B Muhcu) – Lay out in the home straight.

**Little Pumba** (A Darmanin) – Performed below expectations. Stewards will follow up with trainer C Roach regarding the gelding's performance.

**Gee Gees Can Tell** (T Germaine) – Rider T Germaine was granted permission to not claim any of his allowance.
