RACE 1 – AMANDA SOUTHWELL MAIDEN– 1150METRES

Maleluji (E Kacmaz) – Approaching the winning post, when improving in a tight run to the inside of Skilled Angel, had to be checked to avoid the heels of White Cliffs, which was commencing to lose ground. Rider E Kacmaz was severely reprimanded under AR131(a) careless riding and advised that he must react quicker when in similar circumstances..

Midnight Quest (D Parish) – Over raced in the early and middle stages. Approaching the 600 metres when over racing had to be restrained off the heels of King Mawingo.

Pingu (B McCoull) – Performed below expectations. Rider B McCoull explained that the gelding was unable to maintain its position early which left him further back than intended, however could offer no further explanation for the performance.

Roger Verbal Kint (T Voorham) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Lay in in the home straight.

Skilled Angel (C Graham) – Passing the winning post restrained when tightened for room between Roger Verbal Kint which was laying in and Maleluji which shifted out after checking off heels.

Thebolt (B Muhcu) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

RACE 2 – PETUNA SEAFOOD AND GOURMET PANTRY MAIDEN – 1150 METRES

A Tad More (T Voorham) – Lay in in the home straight. Performed below expectation. Rider T Voorham stated that the filly did not begin as well as expected and as a result, raced slightly further back. T Voorham added that after being caught wide she elected to obtain cover, however upon straightening and when placed under pressure the filly was inclined to lay in.

Gee Gee Seemore (P Lui) – Shifted in abruptly at the start, making heavy contact with Gold Digger.

Gee Gees Turf Talk (R Bishop) – Near the 600 metres, steadied off the heels of Tessie when the pace eased.

Gold Digger (E Kacmaz) – Bumped heavily at the start by Gee Gee Seemore and was taken in onto Need's Love'n.

Jayemara (B McCoull) – Lay in in the home straight.

Needs Love'n (T Germaine) – Had to be checked at the start when tightened for room between Gold Digger, which had been taken inward by Gee Gee Seemore and A Portrait, which had been taken out slightly by Tessie.

Revolution Queen (A Darmanin) – Commenced awkwardly, then knuckled, unbalancing rider A Darmanin. Raced three wide without cover throughout. Trainer G Stevenson advised that filly will now be spelled.

RACE 3 – FLESH THERAPY BENCHMARK 64 HCP – 1880 METRES

Geegee Blackprince (R Bishop) – Rider R Bishop was reprimanded under AR132(7)(a)(i) for using his whip in consecutive strides prior to the 100 metres.

One Way Ticket (NZ) (A Darmanin) – Rider A Darmanin stated that gelding was not suited by being challenged for the lead.

Supergrass (S Carr) – Held up rounding the home turn until approaching the 200 metres, then steadied when disappointed for a run between It's A Battle, which shifted in slightly and Noosafy, as a result was held up for a short distance before shifting out abruptly to obtain clear running.

Barjeel (C Newitt) – Slow into stride.

Geegees Lillybet (A Patis) – Approaching the 200 metres was held up for a short distance before then being inconvenienced by Supergrass (S Carr), which shifted out to obtain clear running. S Carr was advised to exercise far greater care than she did on this occasion.

Paper Kites (D Parish) – Approaching the 100 meters had to be steadied when momentarily tightened for room by One Way Ticket, (A Darmanin) which shifted in slightly. A Darmanin was advised to exercise care when shifting ground.

All Well (IRE) (E Kacmaz) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Commenced to weaken from the 600 metres. When questioned regarding the tactics adopted, rider E Kacmaz explained that he had been instructed to be positive on the gelding and after being caught wide in the early stages, he elected to push forward from the 1400 metres in anticipation that the leaders would ease after setting a solid tempo, however from the 1100 metres, it was apparent that the leaders were not coming back and this left him wide without cover for the remainder. E Kacmaz was advised that he had erred in these tactics and ought to have restrained earlier than he did. E Kacmaz was reminded of his obligation to ensure that he rides his mounts in a manner that is not left open to further query. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal an abnormalities.

RACE 4 – THE WHITE WARDROBE MDN/CL1 – 1880 METRES

Fontein Harry (T Germaine) – Fractious in the barrier, a warning was issued. Approaching the 400 metres, steadied off the heels of Chevy's Star. Performed below expectations. Rider T Germaine explained that the gelding failed to respond to his riding when placed under pressure. A post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any abnormalities. Trainer J Blacker will contacted in the coming days regarding the performance

Gee Gee Caughtya (B McCoull) – Lay in over the final 100 metres. An inquiry will be conducted into the whip use of rider B McCoull.

Chevy's Star (T Voorham) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Emmceeoh (C Graham) – Slow into stride (2L).

Gee Gee Flicker (R Bishop) – Over raced in the early and middle stages.

Orange Roughie (S So) – Slow into stride. Over raced in the early and middle stages. Near the 1300 metres, when over racing steadied off heels and shifted wider on the track, before being allowed to stride forward from the 1150 metres. Near the 100 metres, steadied when tightened for room by Wineglass Bay, (E Kacmaz) which shifted in when not fully clear and as a result, bumped with Visavis, becoming unbalanced. E Kacmaz was severely reprimanded under AR131(a), careless riding. Lost an off front racing tip during running.

Poole Harbour (B Muhcu) – Held up for clear running between the 400 metres and 200 metres. Approaching the 50 metres, had to be steadied when tightened between Gee Gee Caughtya, (B McCoull), which lay in under pressure and Orange Roughie, which shifted out after bumping with Visavis. B McCoull was advised to exercise care in similar circumstances.

Visavis (S Carr) – Near the 100 metres became unbalanced after bumping with Orange Roughie, which had been taken inward by Wineglass Bay.

Wineglass Bay (E Kacmaz) – Over raced in the early and middle stages. When questioned regarding the apparent improved performance of the gelding Trainer A Fulton explained that the gelding was more suited by the step up in distance today and may not have been suited to the shorter distance that it raced over at its first start for the stable on 24 April 2019 at Launceston (1400 metres). A Fulton added that the gelding may not have been suited to the soft track conditions at Launceston and had derived fitness from its first up run

RACE 5 – CLOVER HILL WINES BENCHMARK 58 HCP– 1350 METRES

Kathonious (T Germaine) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

Cascade City (S Carr) – Slow into stride.

Al Cosmic Gift (B Muchu) – Approaching the winning post, carried outwards slightly by Breathtaking, (C Newitt) which shifted out under pressure. C Newitt was advised to exercise care when shifting ground.

Our Artie (R Bishop) – Near the 1200 metres, had to be steadied when Tambro's Game, (T Voorham) shifted in when not fully clear. T Voorham was advised to exercise care.

Breathtaking (C Newitt) – Lay out under pressure over the concluding stages.

Astrobelle (C Graham) – Required to be re saddled upon arriving at the barrier. Reared after being loaded into its barrier. In not taking action against the mare, it was taken into account that they had been loaded into its barrier without a blindfold which is part of its gear.

Flying Geepee (E Kacmaz) – Trainer A Fulton was fined \$50 for presenting the gelding without visors which are part of its nominated gear.

RACE 6 – URBAN WALL BENCHMARK 58 HCP– 1009 METRES

Gee Gees Cricket (P Lui) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Over the concluding stages, held up behind Gee Gee Rich Ruby, which had shifted in under pressure.

Wharfie's Boy (D Ganderton) – Raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages.

Winky Dink (A Patis) – Rider A Patis explained that after beginning only fairly the mare raced back further than anticipated. A Patis added that the mare may not have been suited coming back in distance, however she was satisfied with the way that it finished off the race. A Patis, Further added that the mare may have come to the end of its preparation. Trainer G Stevenson advised that the mare will now have a let up.

Just Jay Jay (B McCoull) - Over the final 100 metres was held up and disappointed for a run to the inside of I Love Champagne and was not able to be tested to the finish.

Party Planner (T Voorham) – Near the 700 metres steadied outward over the heels of I Love Champagne, (T Baker), which had shifted in when not quite clear. T Baker was advised to exercise care when shifting ground.

Red Gucci (C Newitt) – An inquiry will be conducted into the whip use of rider C Newitt.

Gee Gee Rich Ruby (R Bishop) - An inquiry will be conducted into the whip use of rider R Bishop.

Ansaam (E Kacmaz) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

Arlington Heights (I Toker) – Tailed the field throughout the race. Rider I Toker could offer no explanation for the performance other than the gelding could be better suited over a further distance. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination

RACE 7 – HARDING'S HOTMIX CLASS 1 HCP – 1150 METRES

Newhart (C Newitt) – Underwent a veterinary examination after arriving on course, and was subsequently passed suitable to race.

Border Protection (A Darmanin) – Slow into stride.

Acheeva Dream (E Kacmaz) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Limerick City (B Muchu) – Lay out in the home straight.

Cape Cardinal (C Graham) – After becoming fractious in the barrier and getting its leg up, underwent a veterinary examination and was declared a late scratching on veterinary advice at 3.34pm. Stewards ordered all monies invested on Cape Cardinal to be refunded in full. All successful wagers made prior to 3.34 pm were to be paid less three cents in the dollar on the face value of the win ticket and less four cent in the dollar on the face value of the place ticket. The gelding must now trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing again.

Gee Gee Ladybird (S Carr) – Late scratching at 11:39am on veterinary advice due to swelling to the near hind. A veterinary clearance is required prior to racing again.

Meetony (A Patis) – Near the 50 metres eased away from the heels of Border Protection which had been taken out slightly by Limerick City.

Gee Gee Musicmaker (S So) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

RACE 8 – STRONGBOW ROSE CIDER BENCHMARK 64 HCP – 1150 METRES

Into the Night (C Graham) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Braccenby (S So) – Restrained at the start.

Gee Gee Pureblonde (A Patis) – Lay in in the home straight.

Epic Event (A Darmanin) – Tailed the field throughout the race. Rider A Darmanin stated that the gelding attempted to buck shortly after the start and felt very awkward in its action. Due to this he elected to not ride the gelding out from the 800 metres. A Darmanin added that the gelding was making an unusual respiratory sound when it returned to the mounting yard. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities. Trainer A Moore was advised that the gelding must now trial to the satisfaction of Stewards before racing again. A Moore advised that the gelding would now be retired.

GENERAL

RACE 3 – DELORAINÉ HOTEL CLASS 1 HANDICAP – 1400 METRES

Pretzel Logic – Trainer A Trinder advised that the filly had pulled up satisfactory and in his view may not have handled the soft track conditions. A Trinder added that he would continue on with the filly's preparation.

RACE 8 – KELLY GANG TIMBERS BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP – 1200 METRES

Little Pumba (A Darmanin) – Shortly after the start had to be restrained to avoid the heels of Invincible Rock when tightened for room between that gelding which shifted in and Gee Gee Sun Valley. When questioned regarding his riding of the gelding, A Darmanin explained that after receiving some tightening on jumping away the gelding settled slightly further back than intended. A Darmanin added that the gelding was off the bit for the majority of the race and he had expected the gelding to handle the soft track conditions today however it felt awkward in its action. A Darmanin added that it was his intention to track Silver Road into the race from the 500 metres however the gelding failed to keep in contact and then early in the straight he was in two minds whether to ease up on the gelding as its action felt awkward, however it then commenced to pick up ground and he then elected to continue to ride out hands and heels. Trainer C Roach advised that the gelding had pulled up well and he would continue on with its preparation.
