Comments / Explanations:

The explanations for the dual engagement of D Parish and late engagement of M Ulucinar were accepted.

RACE 1 – KEVIN SHARKIE TASBRED MAIDEN – 1150 METRES

Arapaho Chief (T Baker) – Shifted out and bumped with Hampton Street at the start. Raced greenly throughout. Hung out making the 600 metre turn and then compounded in the home straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no apparent abnormalities.

Belmista (G Catania) – Caught three wide without cover throughout.

Appollo Landing (S Carr) – Raced wide throughout. Rider reported that the mare failed to respond to her riding in the home straight.

Church Bells (P Lui) – Carried wider on the home turn when Unedited shifted ground to its inside.

Go Wild Frankie (C Jordan) – Disappointed for a clear run and restrained near the 300 metres when Gee Gee Enuf Speed shifted in to its outside. Stewards advised, B Muhcu he should exercise more care in the future. In not taking more severe action stewards took into account the interference suffered was of a low level and the run had closed before Go Wild Frankie was established.

Sh'bourne De Lago (B Louis) – Raced greenly in the early stages and laid in on the home straight.

Gee Gee Enuf Speed (B Muhcu) – Shifted in under pressure near the 300 metres, inconveniencing Go Wild Frankie.

Unedited (I Luximon) – Shifted out under making the home turn.

Hampton Street (T Doyle) – Bumped and became unbalanced near the 600 metre turn when Arapaho Chief hung out at that point.

Gold Gown (I Toker) – Was declared a late scratching at 12:07pm, as there was no available rider on course. Following deductions were ordered:

Merv Decides (1st) – 0 cents a win & 1 cents a place

Belmista (2nd) – 2 cents a place

Go Wild Frankie (3rd) – 4 cents a place.

RACE 2 – LADBROKES MDN/CL1 – 1650 METRES

Le Monde De Lucas (I Luximon) –Raced wide throughout.

Needarein (B Muhcu) – Jumped awkwardly, slow to begin. Laid in under pressure on the home straight.

One Lotto (G Catania) – Bumped by Tassie O'Reilly NZ, which shifted out entering the home straight.

Rising Light (D Pires) – Fractious in the barriers.

Tassie O'Reilly NZ (D Ganderton) – Shifted out on the home turn, bumping with One Lotto.

Zegrey (C Jordan) – Bumped by Under His Eye which shifted out at the start, then steadied off the heels of Rising Light. Over raced in the early stages. C Jordan reported that the buckle on her reins became undone in the home straight and near the 100 metre mark she dropped her offside rein and was unbalanced, placing her at a disadvantage. Subsequent to the race the bridle was examined, and the reins were found to be in good condition with buckle and keeper intact. No further action was taken.

Bullock NZ (M Ulucinar) – Carried out marginally by Urban Equity on jumping and was then slow into stride.

Signal Hill (E Byrne Burke) – Shifted in under pressure passing the 200 metres before being corrected by the rider.

Urban Equity (T Baker) – Shifted out on jumping.

RACE 3 – KEVIN SHARKIE TASBRED MAIDEN – 1350 METRES

Prince of Passion (M Ulucinar) – Slow into stride, raced greenly in the early stages, hung out in the back straight and shifted in abruptly away from heels of Southern Wind entering the home straight.

Southern Wind (S Carr) – Laid in entering the home straight.

The Beekeeper (T Baker) – Caught wide in early and middle stages until it worked forward, to race outside the leader at 600 metre mark.

Boss Cheyenne (I Luximon) – Slow to begin, shifted in under pressure approaching the winning post. Apprentice, I Luximon was advised that he should correct his mounts sooner than he had done on this occasion.

Gee Gee Cloudy Bay (D Parish) – Elected to work forward to the lead when the pace was slowed passing the 1200 metres.

Powerful Pebbles (C Jordan) – Steadied off the heels of Gee Gee Cloudy Bay when the pace eased near the 1100 metres. Laid in under pressure in the home straight.

Soulita (G Catania) – Hung in, entering the home straight.

Tough Cookie (B Louis) – Tough Cookie hung in in the home straight.

RACE 4 – CARLTON AND UNITED BREWERIES BENCHMARK 60HCP – 1350 METRES

Weekend Whisky (S Carr) –When questioned S Carr stated she raced further back than intended when caught behind Master Truffles. Held Up behind Master Truffles from the 550 metres to the 400 metres. Shifted out near the 200 metres when not clear of Mariposa which had to steady over that geldings' heels. S Carr was reprimanded for careless riding under AR 131(a).

Little Raven (T Baker) –Hung in and compounded entering the home straight. A post race veterinary examination revealed no apparent abnormalities.

Mariposa (I Luximon) –Steadied over the heels of Weekend Whisky near the 200 metres.

RACE 5 – THE IMPERIAL BENCHMARK 66 HCP – 1880 METRES

Possession (B McCoull) –Declared a late scratching at 8.30am for veterinary reasons.

Dargo (D Ganderton) –Rider cautioned for using the whip on one occasion after the finish.

High Maintenance (C Jordan) – Inconvenienced at the start when Red Fiore shifted out. Caught wide throughout. C Jordan stated that she had been unable to restrain and take up a position closer to the rail. She also felt that it would have been detrimental to attempt to go further forward.

Costero (I Luximon) – Slow to begin. Slow to muster speed when attempting to improve from the 700 metres.

Encosta Fiorente (G Catania) – Shifted out on jumping. Over raced in the early stages.

Red Fiore (P Lui) – Inconvenienced at the start when Wineglass Bay shifted out, then stumbled.

Wineglass Bay (B Muhcu) – Jumped awkwardly and was slow to begin.

RACE 6 – GOODSTONE GROUP CLASS 1 HCP – 1150 METRES

Freelancer (D Ganderton) – Fractious in barriers. Stewards cautioned trainer, B P Campbell, on the gelding's manners. Hampered on jumping by Fighting Floyd which had been carried in.

Fighting Floyd (B Louis) –Hampered on jumping by Outbound shifting in. Shifted out near 250 metres hampering Society Bill. Stewards will inquire into these circumstances at a date to be fixed.

Gee Gee Can Win (B Muhcu) – Over raced approaching the 700 metre mark. Shifted out carrying Gee Gees Jennia wider on the track.

Outbound (E Byrne Burke) – Shifted in on jumping, bumping with Gee Gee Real Deal. Gee Gee Real Deal then shifted in, carrying Fighting Floyd in onto Freelancer, which was hampered.

Society Bill (I Luximon) – Hampered at the 250metres. A post-race veterinary examination of Society Bill revealed no apparent abnormalities.

Gee Gee Real Deal (G Catania) – Raced three wide without cover

Gee Gees Jennia (T Doyle) –Bumped by Gee Gee Can win near the 700 metres.

Port Berry NZ (C Jordan) – Made the turn at the 600 metres awkwardly.

RACE 7 – TASMANIAN HORSE TRANSPORT BENCHMARK 62 HCP – 1150 METRES

Barjeel (C Jordan) – Stumbled after the start and lost ground.

Our Shinkansen (E Byrne Burke) – Hung in, approaching the 100 metre mark Apprentice E Byrne Burke having to stop riding and straighten her mount.

Fitzwilliam (D Pires) – Compounded form the 300 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have a poor recovery rate.

Trojan Storm (B Muhcu) – Was held up from 500 metres until the 400 metres, behind the tiring Apollo Rocket.

Merciabelle (S Carr) – Inconvenienced at the start and lost ground when Trojan Storm was carried outwards.

Apollo Rocket (D Ganderton) – Shifted out on jumping, tightening Trojan Storm out onto Merciabelle. Apollo Rocket commenced to tire from the 500 metres, to be beaten considerable distance. Rider, D Ganderton, reported that he felt there was something amiss with the mare. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no apparent abnormalities.

RACE 8 – BIRDCAGE TAVERN & FUNCTION CENTRE BENCHMARK 74 HCP – 1150 METRES
