Comments / Explanations:

RACE 1 – BIRDCAGE TAVERN OPEN HCP– 1150 METRES

No report.

RACE 2 – LEIGH JORDAN ONE AGENCY COLLINS REAL ESTATE MAIDEN – 1150 METRES

Belmista (D Pires) – Caught wide early.

Madetobebroken (B McCoull) – layed out making the 600 metre turn.

The Beekeeper (T Baker) – Commenced to over race near the 600 metre mark. Held up from entering the home straight until passing the 200 metres.

Wane's Quest (C Jordan) – Bounded on jumping. Layed in, in the home straight.

Alpine Annie (P Lui) – Raced greenly in the early and middle stages. Hung out making the 600 metre turn.

Luce Della Luna (I Luximon) – Was held up for a clear run to the inside of Champagne Cinders over the final 100 metres.

Bondi Tiff (B Muhcu) – Slow to muster early speed and hung in throughout.

Warrior Lass – Declared a late scratching at 9:10am, as there was no available rider. The following deductions were ordered:

Madetobebroken (1st) – 1 cent a win & 1 cents a place
Poet Warrior (2nd) – 1 cent a place
The Beekeeper (3rd) - 1 cent to place

Unedited – Late scratching due to no available ride at 9:45am. The following deductions were ordered:

Madetobebroken (1st) – 0 cent a win & 1 cents a place
Poet Warrior (2nd) – 1 cent a place
The Beekeeper (3rd) - 1 cent to place

RACE 3 – LADBROKE IT! MAIDEN– 1650 METRES

Arapaho Chief (I Luximon) - Ridden forward early, was unable to take forward position and commenced to over race when restrained. Rolled out near the 1300 metre, bumping with Tassie Miss and continued to race greenly until 1100 metres. Compounded over the concluding stages to be beaten a considerable distance. Arapaho Chief underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no apparent abnormalities. Stewards ordered that the gelding undergo a trial to their satisfaction prior to racing again. Trainer, T Hanson, stated the gelding will now be retired.

Prince of Passion (P Lui) – Hung out making the home turn and shifted wider on the track to race on the extreme outside. Apprentice, Peter Lui, was advised he should have taken more immediate corrective action than he had done on this occasion.

Tassie Miss (E Byrne Burke) – Bumped by Arapaho Chief passing the 1300 and 1200 metre mark and commenced to over race. Raced three wide throughout. When questioned on the below market expectation performance of this mare, E Byrne Burke stated that she was unable to take up a position close to the rail and she had been bumped on several occasions by Arapaho Chief in the early stages which hampered her efforts to obtain a position closer to the rail.

Who's The Rider (C Jordan) – Layed in over the concluding stages.

RACE 4 – CARLTON AND UNITED BREWERIES BENCHMARK 60 HCP– 1650 METRES

Needarein (S Carr) – Layed in entering the home straight. S Carr pleaded guilty to a charge under the provisions of AR 132(7)(a)(ii) in that she used her whip 10 times prior to the 100 metres. After considering submissions on penalty, which included her guilty plea, record under the rule and the breach being of a high level, her licence to ride in races was suspended for three Tasmanian race dates. This will commence midnight September 5 2021 and expire at midnight 26 September 2021.

Zegrey (M Ulucinar) – Inclined to over race in the early and middle stages. Held up near the 450 metres behind San You.

Little Raven (T Doyle) – Momentarily crowded near the 200 metres when Zegrey shifted out to obtain a clear run.

RACE 5 – THAI IMPERIAL BENCHMARK 70 HCP – 1880 METRES

Possession (B McCoull) – Rider reported the gelding failed to travel throughout the race and did not respond his riding in the home straight. He therefore elected not to ride it out from the 150 metre mark. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near hind. Possession will be stood down from racing until a veterinary certificate of soundness is received. Trainer M Trinder reported that the gelding would now be spelled.

Dargo (D Ganderton) – Shifted out under pressure entering the home straight. Dargo underwent a post-race veterinary examination as it had blood in its mouth on returning to scale. This revealed it had suffered an incisor abrasion.

RACE 6 – GOOSTONE GROUP CLASS 1 HCP – 1009 METRES

Gee Gee Rhythm (B McCoull) – Jumped awkwardly, as a result raced back in the field and travelled wide. When queried on the below market expectations performance, B McCoull confirmed that after beginning awkwardly he was caught wide he also felt that the mare would benefit from a little further distance.

Fun 'N' Frolic (S Carr) – Compounded over the concluding stages.

Gee Gee Real Deal (T Doyle) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Sweetsop (T Baker) – Jumped awkwardly and was slow to begin. Over raced in the early stages.

Gee Gees Jennia (T Doyle) – Slow to begin, had to be steadied off the heels of Soulita near the 600 metre mark.

Destiny Force (D Parish) – Rider reported, lost its near-fore plate and synthetic hoof filler during running. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

RACE 7 – KEVIN SHARKIE BENCHMARK 60 HCP – 1150 METRES

Our Shinkansen (E Byrne Burke) – Raced three wide throughout. Carried wider at 600 metres when Rhyme Writer shifted out.

Rhyme Writer (C Jordon) – Jumped awkwardly. Steadied off heels near the 600 metres before shifting out carrying Our Shinkansen wider.

Tycoon's Daughter (M Ulucinar) – Stumbled on pulling up harmlessly dislodging M Ulucinar. A post-race veterinary report revealed the mare to be lame with a ligament injury to the near foreleg. A veterinary certificate of soundness will be required before racing again.

Tambros Bobby (T Doyle) – Slow to muster early speed.

RACE 8 – TASMANIAN HORSE TRANSPORT BENCHMARK 66 HCP – 1350 METRES

The start of this event was delayed 1 minute by a race on the Sunshine Coast running late.

Stewards viewed the film of the start before correct weight, regarding Cheeky One at the start. After viewing the films Stewards were satisfied that Cheeky One had reared as the gates opened due to its own manners and therefore declared correct weight.

Cheeky One (E Byrne Burke) – Reared on jumping and was very slow to begin.

Kwai (D Ganderton) – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination at the barriers upon the riders request and was passed fit to race. Raced ungenerously throughout and was eased down prior to the winning post. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame in the near hind leg. A veterinary certificate of soundness will be required prior to racing again. Trainer, B Campbell advised that the mare would be retired from racing.

GENERAL

DRC Race 7 29/08/2021

Stewards inquired into the circumstances which resulted in Port Berry (NZ) and Little Hot Missile beginning from the incorrect barriers. After consulting with Racing Australia it was established that the handicappers order for these two horses had changed in error after the release of acceptances at 10.25am. This was not rectified until 12.56pm when the associated meeting reports had already been generated. ORI staff remained unnotified of the change.

On loading the horses Mr Armstrong (starter) had been questioned by T Baker (Little Hot Missile) as to whether he had been loaded into the correct barrier and was advised that he had. Mr Lui (Port Berry (NZ)) stated he thought he may have been loaded into the wrong gate but did not question it at the time. Mr Armstrong and Mr Lui have been advised that in any similar circumstances in future where a conflict or query arises, they must seek clarification before proceeding with the starting process.
