Comments / Explanations:

Trainer Ms L Gray's explanation for the late rider declaration was accepted.

RACE 1 – UNIQUE DOORS & WINDOWS BENCHMARK 66 HCP – 1150 METRES

Vivilici (E Byrne Burke) – Jumped awkwardly at the start and was slow to begin two to three lengths. Slow to muster early speed. Over raced in the middle stages. Blundered in the going after clipping itself on the near fore approaching the home turn. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no apparent abnormalities.

Red Letter Lady (B McCoull) – Fractious in barriers.

Assaranca (D Ganderton) – Fractious in barriers, a warning was continued on the mares barrier manners. Re-saddled and bridle adjustment behind barriers prior to the start. Approaching the 100 metres was held up behind Rising Hsiang.

RACE 2 – THAI IMPERIAL BENCHMARK 60 HCP – 1350 METRES

Gee Gee Bay Watch (D Ganderton) – Over raced in the early and middle stages.

Northern Spirit (T Baker) – Bumped with Rhyme Writer on jumping.

Rhyme Writer (C Jordan) – Bumped with Northern Spirit on jumping.

RACE 3 – GOODSTONE GROUP MAIDEN – 1350 METRES

Glavya Onice (I Luximon) – Jumped awkwardly and was slow to begin. Over raced in the early and middle stages. Raced greenly and shifted out in the home straight. Raced wide throughout.

Gold Gown (C Jordan) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Sh'Bourne De Lago (B McCoull) – Stewards granted permission for rider, B McCoull, to ride the mare half a kilogram over the allotted weight.

Van D'Oro (T Baker) – Rider T Baker reported that he thought there was something amiss with the mare. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no apparent abnormalities.

Unedited (P Lui) – Was a late scratching on veterinary advice at 9.00am, after sustaining grazing on both knees. Trainer, G McCulloch was advised that a veterinary certificate of soundness will be required prior to the filly's next race start.

RACE 4 – LADBROKES BET TICKER MAIDEN- 1150 METRES

Brazen Guy – Was a late scratching by order of Stewards at 11:00am, no riders were available.

Cambalago (B Muhcu) – Bumped with Jackjack on jumping. Trainer, L Gaffney, reported to the Stewards that she thought the gelding was lame. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near fore. A veterinary certificate will be required prior to the gelding's next race start. Stewards to follow up with trainer.

Incriminate (B McCoull) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

JackJack (M Ulucinar) – Bumped with Cambalago on jumping. Failed to muster early speed.

Sh'Bourne Brandy – Was a late scratching by order of Stewards at 12:00pm, no available rider.

Puma (I Luximon) – Stewards spoke to rider, I Luximon, regarding the performance of Puma, having its first race start. Rider, I Luximon, stated that it was his intentions to race further forward however the gelding was reluctant to take up a position closer in the field.

Clara Karen (P Lui) – Re-saddled behind the barriers prior to the start. Slow to begin.

Mystical Vixen (E Byrne Burke) – Was a late scratching at 11:44am on veterinary advice, was found to be lame in the near side fore. Trainer, A Trinder, was advised that a veterinary certificate of soundness will be required prior to the fillies next race start.

RACE 5 – KEVIN SHARKIE MDN/CL1 – 1880 METRES

Karnak Kid (B Muchu) – Tightened for room nearing the 150m on the first occasion.

Tassie O'Reilly NZ (I Luximon) – Approaching the 150 metres on the first occasion when improving forward shifted ground inwards tightening Fortitude Valley in onto Karnak Kid. Rider I Luximon was

advised to exercise care when shifting ground inwards and to give his fellow riders the room they are entitled to.

Fortitude Valley (P Lui) – Approaching the 150 metres on the first occasions. Rider, P Lui, when attempting to hold his horse's head outwards, shifted ground inwards tightening the racing room of Karnak Kid. Rider P Lui was advised to exercise more care in future. Fortitude Valley underwent a post-race veterinary examination. Tired over the concluding stages.

RACE 6 – TASMANIAN HORSE TRANSPORT BENCHMARK 60 HCP – 1009 METRES

Gee Gee Goldenlass (B McCoull) – Was slow to muster early speed. Gee Gee Goldenlass underwent a post-race veterinary examination. Stewards spoke to rider, B McCoull, on the below market expectations performance of the mare. Rider, B McCoull, was disappointed on the mare's performance, however, he stated that after being slow to muster early speed and resenting the kick back.

Velino (I Luximon) – Shortly after jumping brushed with So I'm Dreaming, which shifted out.

So I'm Dreaming (P Lui) – Was slow to begin. On jumping, shifted out and brushed with Velino. Shortly after shifted back in brushing with Gee Gee Lucky Jess.

Geegee Lucky Jess (T Baker) – Brushed with So I'm Dreaming shortly after the start. Rider, T Baker, stated that he believed the filly failed to respond to his riding until reaching the 200 metres, then the filly started improving.

RACE 7 – CARLTON AND UNITED BREWERIES CLASS 1 HCP – 1350 METRES

Freelancer (D Ganderton) – Re-saddled behind the barriers prior to the start, and over raced in the early stages. Had a tendency to hang out throughout.

Divisor (T Baker) – The tongue tie was adjusted behind the barriers prior to the start.

Fighting Floyd (B McCoull) – Fighting Floyd shifted ground inward at about the 1200m, crowding Boss Cheyenne. Rider, B McCoull, was severely reprimanded under AR131(a), for allowing his mount to shift in when not fully clear.

Merv Decides (M Ulucinar) – Stewards spoke to rider, M Ulucinar, on the below market expectations performance of the gelding. Rider M Ulucinar stated that on jumping from the barriers, he contacted the side of the barriers injuring his right foot and placed him at a disadvantage throughout the race. He also stated that once he was positioned back in the field gelding was reluctant to go forward with the kick back from the track. The on course doctor and ambulance attended to him post race and was passed fit.

Has The Look (B Muhcu) – Was slow to begin.

Boss Cheyenne (I Luximon) – Approaching the 1200m became unbalanced when it was tightened for racing room between Freelancer which hung out marginally and Fighting Floyd which shifted ground inwards.

RACE 8 – BARRY DIPROSE TRANSPORT BENCHMARK 70 HCP – 1650 METRES

Up Wind (P Lui) – Hung out leaving the home straight.
